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What is the goal of the project?

The main goal of the project is to support immigrants (from Chechnya, Dagestan, Ukraine, Belarus) in the integration in the Polish and European society. The volunteers are supposed to build a bridge between the hosting and incoming community. They will organise activities in the refugee centre – Zajazd „Budowlani” in Białystok, as well as in the temporary shelter for people endangered by homelessness (including refugees). Activitists will help at kindergarten in the refugee centre but also design their own activities for kids in the school age. At the same time, they will visit schools to conduct workshops about migration and their countries to widen up the horizons about cultural diversity. Volunteers will also attend several trainings to be able to spread the word about the refugees’ issues.

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The main tasks of volunteers:

- Supporting a teacher at working in the kindergarten of refugee centre (designing activities and helping at preparation)
- Designing your own extra activities and games for children at school age in the refugee centre and temporary shelter;
- Conducting workshops about refugees, migration, stereotypes and your own culture at schools, NGOs, public institutions;
- Organizing arte therapy classes for mothers in the refugee centre;
- Organizing integrational events (cooking workshops, cultural travels, arts crafts) in the temporary shelter;
- Conducting English classes for migrants at office of foundation;
- Attending the training courses about refugees, pedagogical aspects, arts craft;
- Participating in the Polish language course (80 hours)

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What is covered by the programme?

- Flight tickets
- Health insurance (CIGNA)
- Tickets for local buses
- Accommodation
- Residence permit for people incoming from Turkey (However, you must hold green passport or have Schengen visa)
- All trainings and courses
- Pocket money and food allowance;
- Support from your sending organization.
