

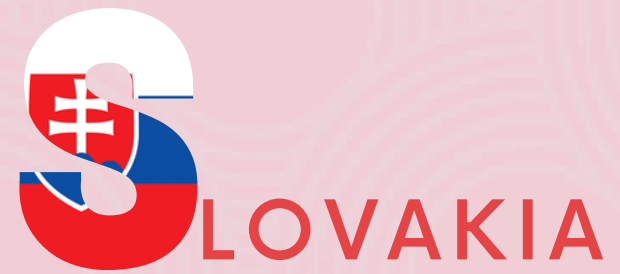

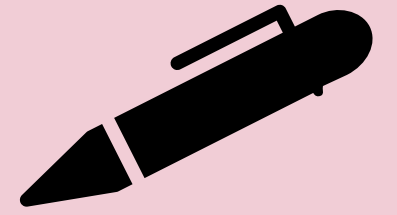

DESCRIPTION

Nowadays we are witnesses of the acts of terrorism, migration, economic crisis, high unemployment rate, ecological problems. Young people have to face often negative news, tensions, opinions of the community towards other cultures which often bring very negative attitudes (prejudice, discrimination, intolerance and even acts of violence) than searching common solutions through intercultural dialogue which seeks to establish links and common ground between different cultures, communities, and people, promoting understanding and interaction.

OUR OBJECTIVES:



- to support 35 young people, out of which 15 with fewer opportunities from the Slovakia, Spain, Poland, Greece, and Turkey to better understand the importance of intercultural dialogue and to offer them the space where they can exchange their ideas about local difficulties and potential solutions on the topic,
- to help the 35 participants from the 5 countries to have a better understanding of the real situation by experience of multicultural city of Istanbul which represents Multicultural Bridges for us where we will also meet participants from another countries,
- to provide the opportunity to the 35 participants from the partner organizations to acquire knowledge about the other countries, and find out the connection between the cultural identity and expressing themselves,
- 35 young people from the 5 partner countries will develop their personal and interpersonal skills, their 8 key competences and as well their soft skills which will help them in the future in their human interactions, active social participation in the local community but also international relations.

PARTICIPANTS OF YOUTH EXCHANGE

FEWER OPPORTUNITIES

The project involves 15 youth with fewer opportunities, who have social obstacles - people facing discrimination because of gender, ethnicity, religion (Poland, Slovakia), cultural - immigrants or refugees (Turkey), youngsters from rural areas, minorities in their host country (Spain, Greece), minorities with less opportunity to travel and exchange ideas. These involved youngsters will be youth who do not have a great level of English or those who do not have the opportunity to practice because in their areas they don't meet very often foreign people or even some of them meet, they are in need to experience intercultural dialogue in order to develop interaction with them. Some of the participants left the school in early ages and participating on this exchange means for them a second chance to learn and develop their competencies.

The types of fewer opportunities they face are social, educational, cultural and geographical and mainly them from the fact that all the partners work for the support of these target groups. The project tends to fulfil their needs.



- From each country there will be 7 participants, which number includes 6 young people (18 – 26 years old) and 1 team leader (18+).
- - 15 of the 35 facing fewer opportunities regarding educational, social, cultural and geographical aspects
- - most of young people haven't participated in Erasmus+ projects before
 - - gender balance
 - - basic knowledge of English
 - - motivation to participate

The objectives of APV are related to practical arrangements mentioned in preparation part (accommodation in Istanbul will be introduced, its location, meeting room, restaurant of the hotel, coffee breaks, we will talk about possibilities for special diets, security and safety of participants will be discussed in details). The detailed travel plan for the Youth exchange will be created according the background of participants. We will talk again the schedule and apply any potential improvements. The leaders will discuss support and mentoring of the group regarding preparation tasks but also during implementation of the YE, dissemination, evaluation and follow-up activities. The visibility plan will be discussed and developed. We will also focus on aspect of inclusion of disadvantaged group as it truly requires more sensitive approach.

We will also talk about risk and crisis management in order to avoid any potential problems to be faced during the project. There will be **7 people** in total (**18+ years old**). **Each country will send one youth leader**, Slovakia and Turkey will be represented by another 1 person as they are coordinating and hosting team and their responsibilities are little bit wider.

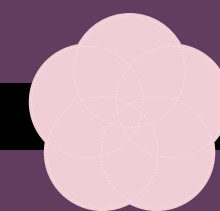
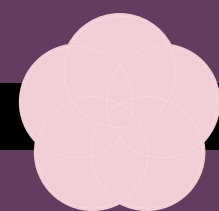
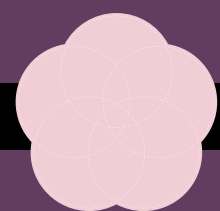
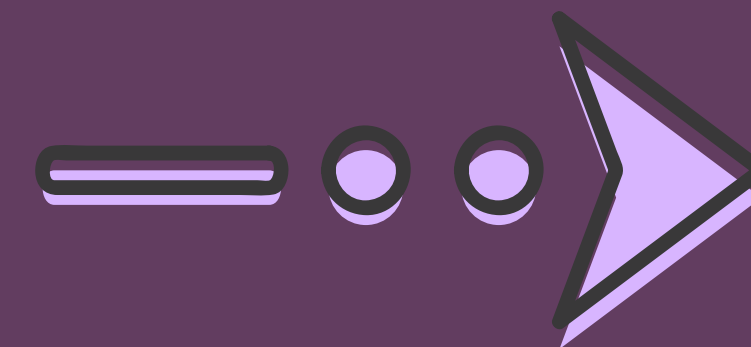


Activities

ALL ACTIVITIES WILL BE CONDUCTED BY THE PARTICIPANTS IN GROUPS WHERE EACH COUNTRY WILL BE REPRESENTED AND WILL BE PRESERVED GENDER EQUALITY. IN ORDER TO MAKE THE PROJECT VISIBLE, SOME OF THE TASKS CONSIST THE PREPARATION PHASE. THIS ALSO HELPS PREPARE THE PARTICIPANTS THEMSELVES. ALL NECESSARY MATERIALS WILL BE PREPARED BY HOSTING TEAM.

The detailed information about preparation tasks and our timetable will be shared in our fb group.



Travel costs will be reimbursed to the sending organizations' bank accounts upon the receipt of all the justification documents and only if all the needed documents have been sent to the coordinating organization.

THE TRAVEL DAYS ARE 6TH AND 13TH OCTOBER 2019.

Reimbursement includes also local transportation costs (but not private transportation). The cheapest means of transport should be used. **YOU HAVE TO TAKE OUR CONFIRMATION BEFORE BUYING YOUR FLIGHT TICKETS OR BUS TICKETS.**

Any change of the arrival and departure days as set in this document should be not made without prior permission of the coordinating organization. Participants are allowed to travel 2 days before or after the project only if the option is economic and confirmed by the coordinating organization. Free time tickets which are not direct to the project place or extra services and classes will not be reimbursed.

The entire duration of the project must be followed by each participant. Arrival documents must be given to the coordinating organization during the exchange and all the rest sent by email (if online) and by post after the project (the returning documents must be firstly scanned to the coordinating organization and then sent by post).

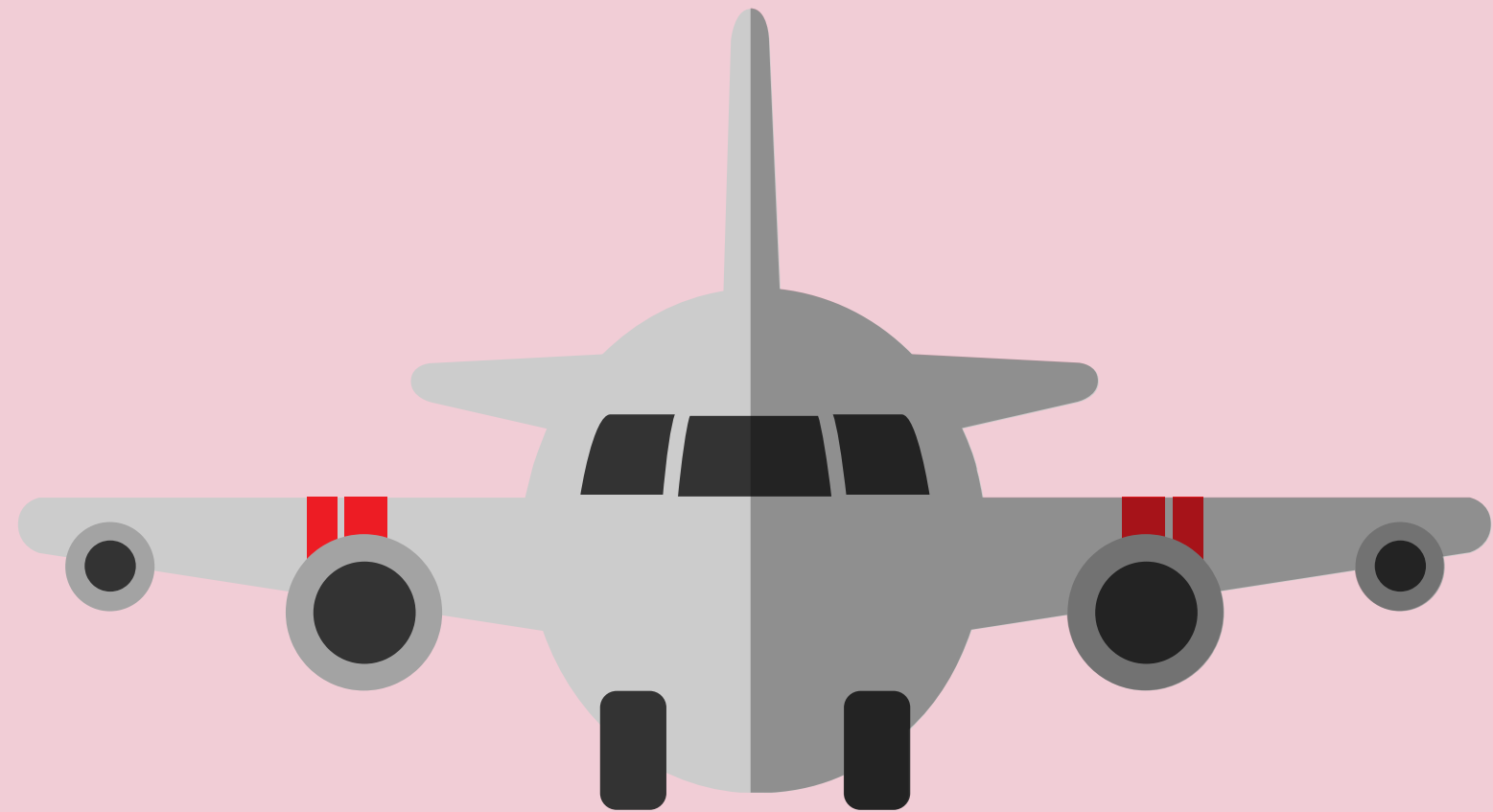

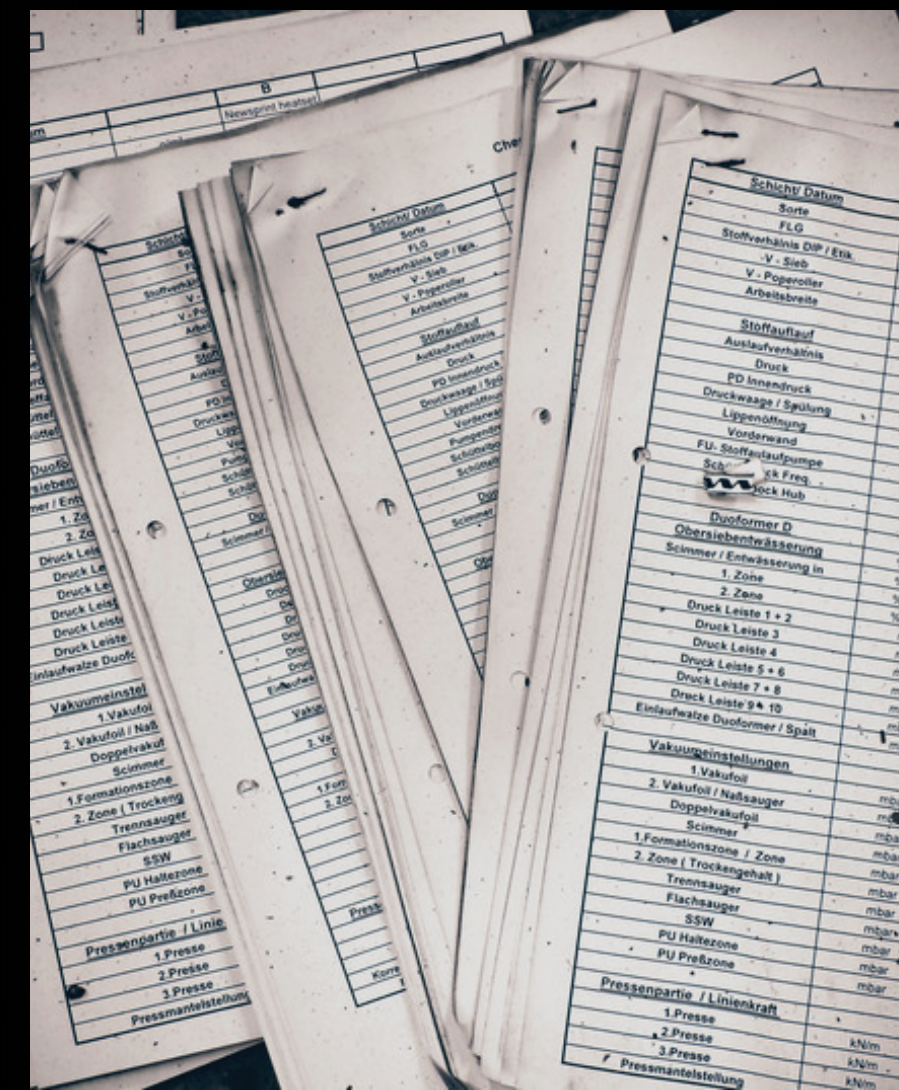
