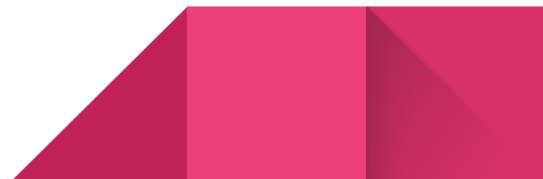
SYTEV

SYTEV develops youth politics and raises the interest about youth contribution on the local and national level. This is accomplished by the creation of youth parliament in our city, which directly works with the city council.



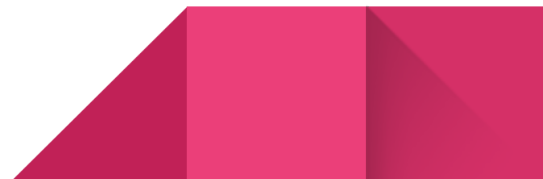

About the project...



"Stand up AGAINST extremism" first main goal is to prevent violent extremism and radicalization through certain measures taken within the local communities. During this project we want to strengthen the role of youth organizations in preventing violent extremism, promote the role of intercultural dialogue between young people and gender mainstreaming in countering violent extremism and radicalization. It is made to work on speech free from hate and extremist views.



The project main objective is to bring updated tools to youth workers so they could better address youths during their work on topics of preventing violent extremism, hate speech and the sources of hatred. We seek to enhance initiatives that challenge extremist narratives, propaganda, cultural, social, religious, political, ideological differences that lead to extremist violence. By reaching out to youths with fewer opportunities, who are victims and actors, we aim to contribute to this objective in the most efficient way.

We aim to promote intercultural dialogue, media literacy, critical thinking and a sense of initiative among them through counter-narratives campaigns.

We aim to develop participants (youth workers skills) so by the end of the project they have developed and enhanced their knowledge, skills and attitudes in preventing extremist violence, are familiar with the conflict resolution and extremist violence prevention, have developed their capacities to apply and use intercultural dialogue in countering the roots of extremist violence in speech and thoughts. Participant shall be familiar with a gender perspective and gender mainstreaming concepts in countering violent extremism and radicalization.




We are also going to enhance work on preventing violent extremism within youth organisations and promote effective civic activism and campaigning against extremist narratives and hate speech.

Venue

You will be accommodated in Penzion Centrál, Oščadnica. Nice ski and mountain area on the north of Slovakia only 30 km from Czech republic and 20 km from Poland.

We invite you to stay 3-4 beds rooms, and if you are comfortable with that, we would like to propose you to stay with the persons from different countries, same gender. Keep on mind that the rooms are not very spacious and please, take it into consideration while packing.

Wifi is available in the venue. However, we can't guarantee its quality, and we recommended not to plan any online meetings or work to do during your stay.



Linen and towels are provided. There are no hair dryers in the rooms neither in the venue to use it. Please bring your own dryer or arrange with the other person from the group.

The workshops will take place in the same building as we will sleep. Conference room is big but sometimes cold. It is good to take sleepers or comfortable shoes. Some workshops and activities can be done outside.

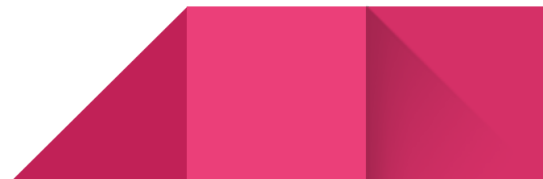

Participants

According to European rules, we have to follow gender balance. Each of these countries (Poland, Moldova, Egypt, Ukraine, Palestine, Bulgaria, Serbia, Greece, Azerbaijan) has to send 3 participants older than 18 years old. These training course is intended to youth workers.



Traveling

The venue of the project is city Oščadnica and the nearest airport is 100 km west of Oščadnica in the Ostrava, very near is Brno, but we are recommending 200 km south of Oščadnica – Bratislava/Vienna. Of course is needed to go from this airport to Žilina, what is the closest big city near Oščadnica and go by train from Žilina to Oščadnica or we can organize minibus from Žilina to Oščadnica. It is 40 minutes.

Food

The currency in Slovakia is EURO.



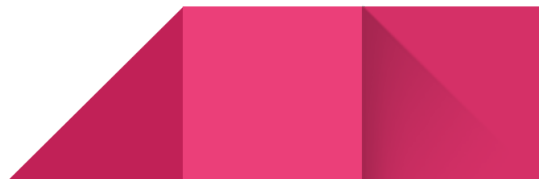
Credit cards

Exchange office

In April the average temperature can reach 5 °C / -5 °C, the weather in the mountains is very tricky.

Trips to Žilina, mountains, High Tatras, ... - we do not organize such trips, neither plan them during the course. In case you would like to visit above mentioned cities and be sure you will have enough time to sightsee, we do recommended you to plan your trip in a way to arrive 1 day earlier or stay 1 day after the project. If the time allows us, we may have few free hours around Oščadnica.
